



NEEDS IDENTIFIED BY TI GEORGIA'S COMMITTEE OF CONCERNED CITIZENS IN SHIDA KARTLI IN 2019



TI Georgia's Committees of Concerned Citizens (CCCs) have identified up to 15 infrastructural problems/needs in 6 settlements in the two municipalities of Shida Kartli (Kareli, Gori).

One of the most important local needs is rehabilitating and fixing the supply of drinking water. The IDP settlement in Khurvaleti requests the supply of drinking water to their settlement. The residents of the villages of Dvani and Uplistsikhe are requesting the laboratory analysis of the drinking water in their settlement. In the village of Uplistsikhe, there is a request for the laboratory analysis of the drinking water as well as the installation of tap water based on the local water sources. Other issues identified were the village's internal roads, state of the kindergartens, etc.

The Committees of Concerned Citizens are informal associations of citizens created through the initiative of our organization that aims to resolve problems in municipalities with direct involvement of the local population and with the mediation provided by our organization.

TI Georgia is going to present the information on the identified problems to the respective local self-governments in the Municipality prior to the adoption of the draft budget so that the issues are resolved in 2020.
